

## How to Setup Sync Cables

In this application document, you will find instructions to set up your pair of Chronos High-Speed Cameras

### Method:

To let two Chronos high-speed cameras communicate with each other, do the following simple steps:

1. Take one end of the connecting cable and insert it into the side panel of the camera, the black or green connector.
2. The end of the cable can only go in one way. If it does not fit easily rotate it 180 degrees and insert it.
3. Do the same with the other end.

Once the connecting cable is in place you can make the two cameras communicate with each other.

**Note:** Sync Cable works for both, 1.4 and 2.1-HD High-Speed Cameras

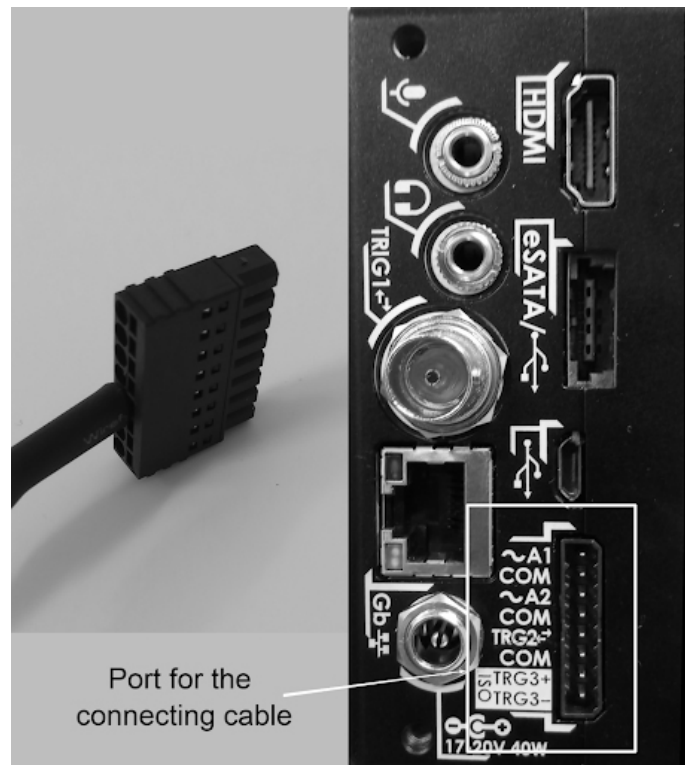


Figure 1. Left. One end of the connecting cable. Right. Side panel of a Chronos camera showing the location of the port for the connecting cable.
